

CT SCAN ORDERING GUIDE

- All patients > 17 must have creatinine within one week of contrast injection
- If Labs are elevated consider the Hydration Protocol For Contrast– (CPOE, Radiology Repository)
- If the patient is a Renal failure patient please consult the patients Nephrologist to approve contrast

Do not order Abd/Pel CT and L–Spine at the same time for Low back pain

Do not routinely order C–spine Ct and Head CT at the same time

Do not order routine chest CT w/o dye– no pertinent info gathered from this exam

Do not order CT Head and CT sinus routinely for Headache

Abdominal CT Scan

Note: In CT, an Abdomen scan is only performed from the top of the liver to the bifurcation of the abdominal aorta, which is at the level of the iliac crest. Anything concerning small or large intestine, vascular system, or urinary tract should be ordered as an Abdomen/Pelvis CT.

Pelvis CT Scan

Note: In CT, a Pelvis scan starts at the iliac crest and goes through the symphysis pubis.

Abdominal/Pelvis/With Contrast

Note: Should be ordered for or any patient with RLQ or LLQ pain, any question of appendicitis, diverticulitis, or any type of colon cancer, ileus, inflammatory bowel disease, abscess, and Crohn 's disease. An Abdomen/Pelvis should be ordered for any exam in which there are questions of any intestinal involvement.
